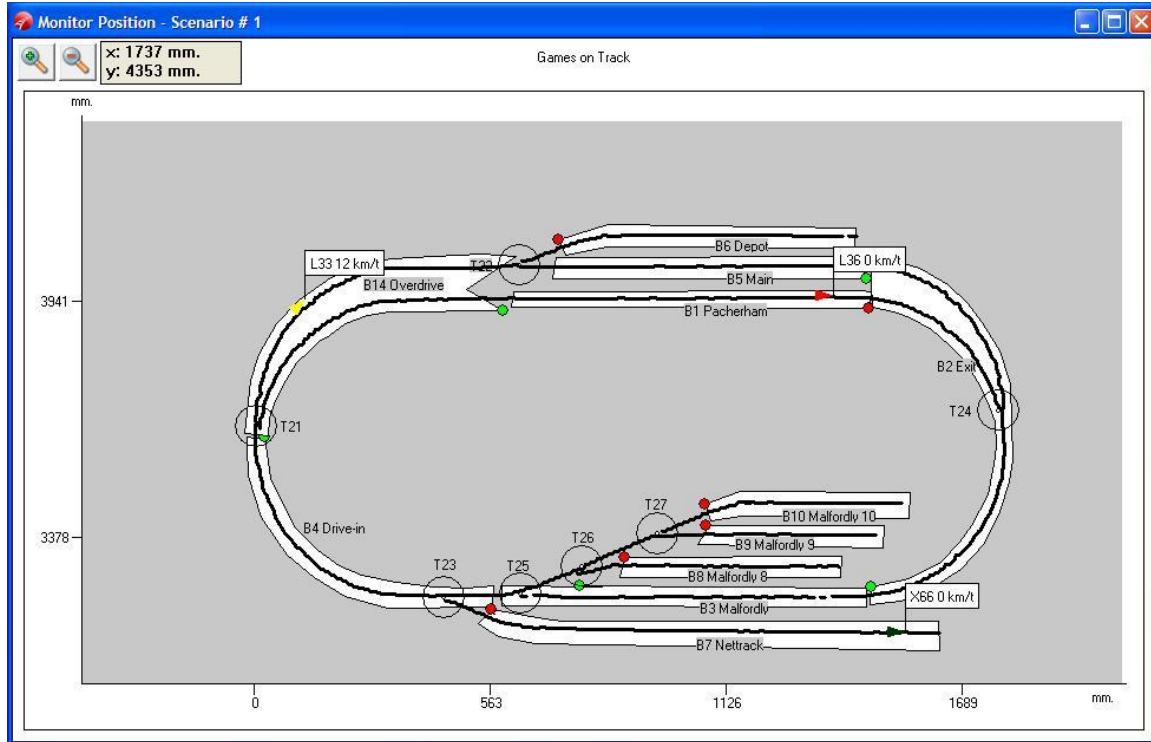


GT-Position Individual Train control



Layout with virtual blocks, turnouts, signals and a track plan as the basis for the examples.

How to make the train blow the whistle

All locos should blow their whistle in 2 seconds each time they pass the station on the main track B5. The name “Whistle” is in the loco table inserted as the name for that very loco-function which contains that sound.

Automation A31
NLW B5 occupied
LB5 whistle on
Pause 2
LB5 whistle off
Pause 10
Repeat

How to brake a loco in a block

Trains which run into the Depot track B6 should be gradually braked down to stop. The train will be driven back from B6 by changing the signal to green and drive out backwards.

You can use V6 red og LB6 stop to stop the train in B6.

Automation A32
NLW B6 occupied
LB6 forward 8
Pause 2
LB6 forward 6
Pause 2
LB6 forward 4
Pause 2
V6 Red
NLW B6 free
Repeat
