2. INTENDED USES:

For application to skin as part of an adhesive device. For EXTERNAL USE ONLY.

3. COMPOSITION:

A soft adhesive paste containing elastomers, a combination of fluid absorbing polysaccharides and isoalkanes.

4. PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL PROPERTIES:

A viscous adhesive paste, hydrophilic. Chemically stable though separation may occur in high temperatures (greater than 50 Deg C).
