

Information for course participants at

"Forklift - B certificate"

Duration: Forklift course (47592) 7 days.

The course consists of 50% theory and 50% practice

At the first day of the course you must meet at 8.00

Admission requirements: At least 18 years. The student must be present at the machine instruction at the first day of the course.

At the beginning of the course, a driving license must be presented. If the student does not have a driving license, a medical certificate must be presented (without photo). The student can participate in the test, but does not receive his/her certificate before presentation of a medical certificate.

Certificate test: The course ends with a theoretical test (taken on a PC) and a practical test, which is assessed by the subject teacher and an external examiner. A test is taken on the machine set belonging to the course, ie. On multiple machines. If the test is not passed, the student must take a new course; however, the censorate may, in accordance with the rules of the ATS/school, assess that a new examination is sufficient (course 47890)

NOTE!!! To be able to take the test, it is a REQUIREMENT that you bring your MitID. If you do not have your MitID with you, you can NOT take the test...

Attire:

The school makes no demands on attire or personal protective equipment. As forklift driving takes place both inside the forklift hall and in the outdoor driving area, appropriate work clothes that can withstand dirt (warm clothes/rainwear) are recommended. The use of safety footwear, a helmet or other personal protective equipment is not repuired.

Absence from the teaching can usually not be accepted due to the duration at the course in concentrated form. It will therefore normally not be possible to take time off from teaching either. For the same reason, homework cannot be ruled out.

Goal:

Participants can independently:

- Drive and operate self-propelled forklifts and / or stackers under different working conditions and in compliance with applicable safety regulations and the requirements of the Traffic act.
- The participants must solve different theoretical and practical tasks alone and in collaboration with others.



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Teaching materials: The students must bring their own paper and pencil, ets. (can be bought in the canteen). Compendiums/textbooks are lent out during the course. Teaching materials that the student borrows from the school must be handed undamaged at the end of the course. If this does not happen, the school reserves the right to demand compensation. Compendiums/textbooks can be purchased from the office. Payment Dankort/mobilepay.
